



Clean Energy Companies to make an appearance in Jalisco

Companies in California with projects that include the renewable energy supply for public transportation, the installation of electric lines and solar panels that provide electric power to schools could reach Jalisco in the coming months.

This was announced during the signing of the memorandum of understanding between Jalisco and the director of the Commission of Conservation and Development of Energy Resources of California, Robert Weisenmiller.

"(The two states) made commitments to work on renewable energy and public transport. Tesla will open places here in Guadalajara and will open infrastructure for electric cars ... other companies are going to come to the state and have strong investments Here ... Another company is also interested in making investments in schools to put solar panels, " said Weisenmiller at Casa Jalisco.

Aristóteles Sandoval, governor of Jalisco, said the signing of this agreement will boost the use of clean energy in the state.

He added that it will serve to replicate best practices in the creation of the Energy Agency jalisciense.
